



COURSE INFORMATION

This course specifically designed to meet the needs of people working in the childcare and early childhood learning industry. It is tailored towards anyone working with children. It covers child-specific first aid in critical situations like anaphylaxis and asthma, as well as addressing common injuries and resuscitation techniques.

Additionally, this course incorporates St John Ambulance's flagship first aid program, covering a comprehensive spectrum of subjects to empower participants in effectively handling emergency scenarios and administering initial aid to injured individuals. It encompasses the most prevalent first aid injuries and health issues.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

For participants interested in enrolling in this course:

- Must provide a valid Unique Student Identifier (USI) at the time of enrolment.
- For courses with pre-learning, access to a reliable device (e.g., computer, laptop, or smart phone) connected to the internet is required.
- Must complete pre-learning before coming to class as topics covered in pre-learning are not covered in the classroom.
- Must be able to perform CPR on a manikin on the floor for 2 minutes.

PARTICIPANT COHORT

This course caters to a diverse range of participants, encompassing educators and support personnel operating within educational and care settings, with responsibilities that extend to managing various first aid emergencies, including those related to asthma and anaphylaxis. Furthermore, parents and grandparents, keen on acquiring the necessary expertise to respond effectively to first aid situations when caring for children, also find value in this course.

In addition to the above, individuals pursuing employment opportunities in education and care settings, who are mandated to complete these competency units as part of their qualifications (e.g., Certificate III or Diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care), form another significant segment of our participants.

COURSE DURATION AND DELIVERY MODES

St John offers the following options:

- **2 days face to face workshop:** This is full face to face course and participants are required to attend both the days.
- 1 day (face to face workshop with prework): This is face to face course and with online prework. Participants must complete the online e-learning module prior to attending the face-to-face workshops for practice and assessment.
- **Assessment only:** The assessment only option will particularly suit participants who regularly apply first aid skills and engage in ongoing learning about first aid.

COURSE OUTLINE

This course covers the following among others:

- CPR techniques on infants, children, and adults
- DRSABCD action plan
- Managing the unconscious breathing casualty
- Incident reporting in a childcare setting
- Using AED's on adults and children
- Asthma and anaphylaxis
- Managing medical conditions such as epilepsy

- Head, neck and spinal injuries
- Chest and abdominal injures
- Facial and eye injuries
- First Aid procedures for bleeding, burns and fractures
- Infection control procedures
- Legal responsibilities of a First Aider
- Safety and risk management
- Managing shock, seizures, bites, stings
